- Please refrain from texting or talking on the phone during the performance.

- Please no talking during the performance. We want to be respectful to the actors on stage and we don't want to miss a moment of the action happening on stage.
- Please don't sing along to the performance. It is tempting, but it can be distracting to those around you.
- If you want to show your excitement and enthusiasm for the performance, clap!
- Except for emergencies, please don't exit the theater until intermission. We want to be courteous to the people around us who are also watching the performance.
